WHAT YOU NEED

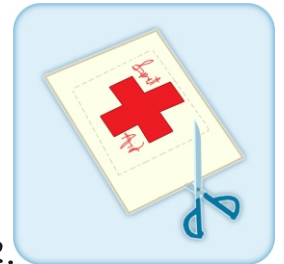
- + Small plastic or metal box, like a lunch pail

INSTRUCTIONS

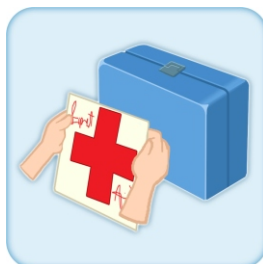
- 1) Print 2 copies of the label (see WHAT YOU NEED).

- 3) Use glue to attach label to each side of the box.

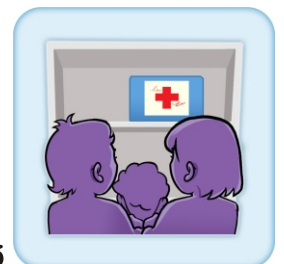
